

The France Chair, or the FJ 136 as it is also known, was designed for the American market in the late 1950's. Though the chair originally was designed for industrial production it still has the characteristic Finn Juhl design details; The seat and back are lifted from the frame while the armrests have the iconic paper knife detail which is also found on the iconic 45 Chair.




